Smart Snacks Regulation

Purpose - to educate and plan for the July 1, 2014 implementation. I have attached a power point presentation. SmrtSnckALittle is just an overview of the regulation. The regulation effects all foods sold on school campus from midnight before until 30 minutes after the school day. Because of the size of the file I will attach a detailed power point to another email. If you are responsible for food sales on campus the detailed version will help you understand the rules. You can also use the Product Calculator at: <https://www.healthiergeneration.org> to determine if food & beverage items meet the guidelines.

Comments

The State did not set a number for Fundraising of non-compliant foods. Therefore none will be allowed. This only complies to foods that are sold on campus, during the school day, that do not meet the Smart Snacks Regulations.

Diet Coke will meet the Smart Snacks criteria for HS students. We are allowed to have a stricter local wellness policy, for our district, if we want.
